The Austin Film Festival's Young Filmmakers Competition is open to all young filmmakers ages 13-18 and is FREE to enter.

You MUST include proof of enrollment from school (copy of student ID or school transcript preferable) along with this form.

The festival committee reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any project.

Works in progress WILL NOT be accepted.

Films must have been completed after April 1st, 2018.

Films must be 12 minutes or less.

To enter more than one film, you MUST use separate entry forms. Each film must be submitted on its own DVD and with its own form — this includes submissions from schools.

All submitted materials become property of the Austin Film Festival and cannot be returned. Austin Film Festival reserves the right to copy any submitted material for Austin Film Festival use only. Please do not send stills unless requested.

If selected, your film must be available to screen during the 26th Annual Austin Film Festival, October 24th - 31st, 2019.
